1. Enhancements to N-MFP XML output.
 - a. **N-MFP Item 1 (Securities Act File Number):** If the field has no value, do not create the `<part1:ContainedFileInformationFileNumber>` element in the XML output.
 - b. **N-MFP Item 7 (Feeder Fund):** If the master fund's CIK NUMBER is empty, only create the `<part1:EntityRegistrantName>` element containing the master fund's NAME in the XML output.
 - c. **N-MFP Item 8 (Master Fund):** Only create a `<part1:EntityRegistrantName>` element in the XML output (which contains a fund's NAME) for each feeder fund whose CIK NUMBER is empty.
 - d. **N-MFP Item 17 (7-day Gross Yield):** Convert value into a percentage by dividing by 100. This value appears in the `<part1:MoneyMarketSevenDayYield>` element in the XML output.
 - e. **N-MFP Item 33 (Security Rating):** If the field has no value, create an empty `<part2:rating>` element in the XML output.
 - f. **N-MFP Item 37 (a) (Identity of Demand Feature Issuer(s)):** Support up to 150 characters in XML output.
 - g. **N-MFP Item 38 (a) (Identity of Guarantor(s)):** Support up to 150 characters in XML output.
 - h. **N-MFP Item 39 (b) (Identity of Enhancement Provider(s)):**
 - i. Output only one instance, rather than duplicates, when multiple enhancement providers are associated with the same enhancement type (N-MFP Item 39 (a)).
 - i. **N-MFP Item 42 (Percent of Net Assets):** If the value of the `<part2:InvestmentOwnedPercentOfNetAssets>` element is **1.0000** or greater, set it to **1.0000**.
2. Improvements to push-button Data Imports.
 - a. **Fund Information**
 - i. Updated import logic for the SEVENDAYSGROSSYEILD field to load the value as a percentage (e.g., The value representing one percent would be **1.0000**; the value for one-tenth of one percent would be **0.1000**).

- ii. Updated import logic to prevent truncation of values in the NAVINCLUDINGAGREEMENTS and NAVEXCLUDINGAGREEMENTS fields to 4 decimal places (6 decimal places are now supported).
 - iii. Added support for loading of negative numeric values.
 - b. **Repo Collateral Information**
 - i. Corrected logic that populates the SECURITY NAME value for repurchase agreement collateral, such that it may come from either an existing English-language or multi-language caption for the specified security. Prior to this update, only an existing English-language caption was sought as the potential source for the SECURITY NAME value.
 - ii. Enhanced import functionality to fully support roll-forward of Issuer and Security captions from previous periods, if these are not supplied in the import source file.
- 3. Improvements to automated Holdings dataload.
 - a. Enhanced performance (speed) of loading data.
 - b. Modified load logic to ensure that existing CIK values for Issuer records are not overwritten with *NULL*.
- 4. Fund Information automated dataload - Added support for loading of negative numeric values.
- 5. Added support for up to 150 characters in the NAME field of several FundSuiteArc pages.
